

GOALS OF ASSESSMENT




ASSUMPTIONS

OUTCOME DATA



- Particular point in time
- Communicate acquired knowledge, skills and attitudes
- Measureable and quantifiable

- ❖ Weaknesses/limitations?
- ❖ Variables' effect on performance/perception?

5. Do we need more data? If so, which data & how will we collect it?
